#### PRESERVING OUR CHURCH HERITAGE!

It might look like a simple building but the rectory next door to our church is of great importance. Catholic clergy began visiting this area around 1872. The first priest, Father Joseph Hoban, was appointed here in 1876 and about that time, the rectory, that you see today was constructed. It was gradually enlarged and a Texas state historical marker was dedicated in 1999 to highlight the significance of new St. Joseph Church that was consecrated in 1899 that stands today.

Our present day church was built in 1893-8. Our church property is in constant need of maintenance. Your help in our ongoing building repair fund will be greatly appreciated. Thank you!
