Saint Joseph has a rich past. Imagine the year 1872 when circuit riding priests began visiting this area on horseback, travelling long distances to perform the sacraments and deliver the word of God. The first priest assigned to live in our rectory was Father Joseph Hoban in 1876. That building still stands next door. The second St. Joseph, our present church, was built in 1893-8 and consecrated in 1899. It requires constant maintenance to the adobe.
